

RIDER REGISTRATION FORM 2016 – CODE OF CONDUCT

- I understand that riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses/ponies may react unpredictably on occasions
- I understand that my child may fall off and could be injured. I accept that risk
- I understand that instructions given are for the safety of my child and agree to follow instructions given to me by the owner and instructors of 'Learn with Smartie'
- I understand that wearing an appropriate riding hat (and body protector) may reduce the severity of an injury should an accident happen and agree that my child will always wear a riding hat (to the latest standard) whilst riding, leading and grooming ponies at the premises of 'Learn with Smartie'. I understand that it is my choice whether or not my child wears a body protector
- I understand that the owner of 'Learn by Smartie' will make decisions based on information I give and agree always to be honest and volunteer information about:
 - my child's age, abilities and riding experience
 - any previous riding accidents
 - any medical condition(s) which may affect my child's ability to ride
- I understand that children are at particular risk around horses/ponies and agree that I will keep children for whom I am responsible under close supervision when they are not being instructed by 'Learn with Smartie'
- I understand that 'Learn with Smartie' may refuse my request for my child to ride for safety or operational reasons
- I understand that competing carries enhanced risk over and above general riding and agree that if I choose for my child to participate in any competition or event, it is up to me to ensure that he/she has the experience and ability to ride the course, including any jumps which form part of it. If I am in any doubt, I will use my judgement and experience and not enter my child
- I understand that, for children aged under 4 years, a parent/guardian will remain with the child at all times
